### **Background:**

The project takes inspiration from the social and educational work of Danilo Dolci, peacemaker and sociologist who first came to Sicily from the North of Italy in the beginning of the 1950s in order to study the conditions of society and try to find the possible elements of change. EDDILI is the result of cooperation between seven organizations from six European countries (Italy, Cyprus, Spain, Germany, Holland, Switzerland) aimed at introducing, experimenting and sharing the reciprocal maieutic approach (RMA) of Danilo Dolci as an educational approach to be used in the field of training of adult learning staff. EDDILI is being implemented in all partner countries simultaneously, achieving this way a strong multiplying effect and a strong European dimension.

### ➤ **The valorisation seminar in Cyprus**

After lots of meetings in partner countries and many local events now the grand finale is coming: From 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> of October 2011 the EDDILI partners will meet for the last time to top off the project activities. In this meeting it is our aim to valorise and exploit the results of the project, the contributions made to the adult education community as

well as the value of collaboration. We will also share good practices and experience about RMA among the whole partnership.

Another aim is to consider common interests for future collaboration and to involve a wide range of existing or potential users who might benefit from the new method the project opened up. If you
