- The creation of an event about traditional gastronomy in Palermo.

The same activities will be carried out simultaneously in four cities in England, Austria, France and Lithuania, all thanks to the ALCE project!

If you wish you will also be able to participate in:

- a three-day training course in Austria,
- a seminary in Lithuania during which you will be able to share your ALCE experiences,
- an event about traditional gastronomy in France.

At the end of the project you will receive a certificate of participation attesting the linguistic, digital, civic, intercultural and organisational competences you will have acquired.

The project is aimed at Sicilian women over 60 years old and immigrant women aged between 18 and 40.
