



## NEEDS

How do we help teachers in career counselling at school?

How does counselling, given by teachers, help in motivating students to learn and look for a job?

The European Erasmus+ KA2 “REFORM” project addresses the development of professional knowledge and skills of educators, in order to better provide educational and employability opportunities for students by increasing their motivation and desire for personal development. During the two-years project the partners, from 7 organizations and 6 different countries, will test, adapt and implement innovative practices that can provide skills educators need in their work as career advisors, implementing a series of trainings and activities to support them.

## KEY ACTIONS

On 3-4<sup>th</sup> June 2019, REFORM partners met in Pyrgos (Greece) to discuss their progress on the development of an integrated methodology for professional guidance in schools. This methodology will include some best practices on career counselling around Europe as well as a bag of tricks of advices on how to work with different target groups of pupils aged 12-14, 14-16, 16-18. The so called “CC-Box” will include materials and educational resources to be used by the educators for delivering career guidance and it will be translated into 6 different languages.

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## FUTURE ACTIONS

On February 2020, 4 educators from each partner country will meet in Portugal to be trained on using the integrated learning methodology for career counselling. We expect teachers to have the opportunity of gaining new knowledge and basic instruments for primary career guidance, meeting with the students to prepare group training sessions. The trained educators will be then able to share with their colleagues what they learnt and will disseminate the results of the project.
