Objectives:

- * To transfer competences and exchanging professional methods helping social structures to welcome and to accompany homeless people
 - * To find out how to ameliorate the modalities of accompaniment and accommodation
 - * To develop awareness tools to be used in the actual and local conditions, allowing young homeless people to be motivated and to be included again in the mainstream
- [Target: associations or institutions which accommodate and coach youth suffering from family breakdown, on the way to marginalization and without a real home]

Activities:

- * A comparative study including a horizontal analysis as well as recommendations provided by the people involved in the project
- * A collection of good practices including a horizontal analysis using social tools
- * A practical bibliography useable by all stakeholders
- * Organisation of conferences by the partners at the end of the Project
