GWfA LOCAL REPORTS



Our 12 Youth Workers carried out desk research and interviews with green job providers and professionals, producing engaging reports on the green job sector in Denmark, Serbia, Italy, Slovenia, and Greece. Building on these results, the project partners compiled and analyzed the findings to create a collective report that compares the green job landscape across all participating countries. The full report is now available for download on the [GRECO website](#).

All partners participated in the final step of the program: dissemination. Each partner organized a local event, bringing together youth workers, municipality representatives, career counselors, and other local stakeholders to share the results of the two-year project. Across six events, 207 relevant stakeholders took part. Participants provided feedback and responded very positively, highlighting that the GRECO project is highly relevant for young job seekers in their countries.

FINAL TPM IN SERBIA



On September 17th, the project partners gathered in Kragujevac, Serbia, for the final Transnational Project Meeting (TPM). As the project nears its conclusion, the partners reflected on key learnings and challenges encountered over the past two years. They reviewed overall progress, outlined the final steps required for project completion, and exchanged insights from the planning and delivery of their Local Dissemination Events. Coming together in person for this last meeting made the occasion especially meaningful as the team now turns toward final reporting and closure.

Surveys local providers on green job needs and adapts local training to increase youth employment in green careers. The local practical project provides hands-on experience for youth workers.

The GRECO team's posts on LinkedIn and Instagram have reached over 5,000 stakeholders, sharing project information and results, exchanging good practices, and highlighting new opportunities for youth to engage in the green labor market.
