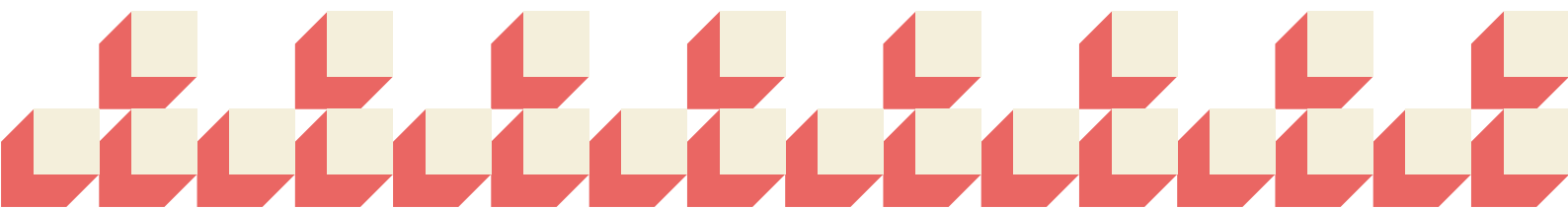
Reflecting on the recent training in Palermo, the MATRIX project team shares the key highlights and takeaways.
